(Principal Rao is discussing the importance of safety and trust with Mrs. Sharma, during routine meeting.)

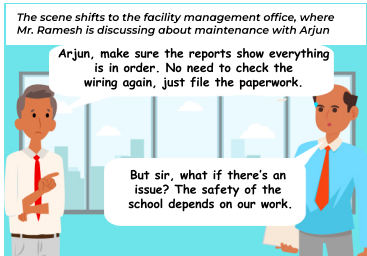


Mrs. Sharma, at Niketan, we prioritize the safety of our students above all. I hope our facility management company takes good care of our school.

A little oversight won't hurt anyone. We're here to make money, no need to waste time on unnecessary checks.



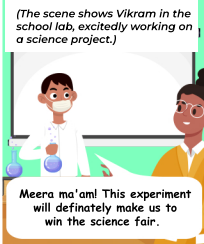
The scene shifts to the facility management office, where Mr. Ramesh is discussing about maintenance with Arjun

Meera ma'am! This experiment will definitely make us to win the science fair.



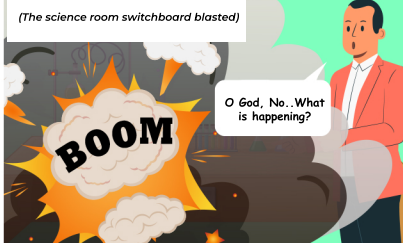
You're doing great, Vikram. Just be careful with the equipments.
